

Addendum to the pattern book: 60 Scarves for Sixty Years

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Dots & Dashes by Mary Pflueger

In the threading draft at far left, omit the 1 that is directly underneath of the 3.
The last set of repeats should read 1-3-2-3 threaded 7X (times).

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5-Step Advancing Twill by Marion Flint

Warp-10/2 Tencel Acorn, approximately 1.5 oz
8/2 Tencel Straw, approximately 2 oz
8/2 Tencel Taupe, approximately 2.3 oz
Weft-8/2 Tencel Spice, 6oz.

This is a random warp. Using the 3 colors above, wind the warp so that the colors are fairly evenly distributed while still being conspicuously random.

Treadle 2-tie up harness 1 (in addition to what is already tied up)

Treadle 3-tie up harness 1 (in addition to what is already tied up)

Treadle 8-omit harness 1 from tie-up

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Large Herringbone Twill by Betsy Szkil

This is a 2/2 twill. Tie-up on treadle 2 should be 1 & 2.

Key for threading blocks:

A – 1324

B – 1526

C – 1728

D – 1827

E – 1625

F – 1423

Threading order: 6A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 4E, 4F, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 4E, 6F

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Raku by Carol Bodin

Tie-up on treadle 1 should be 1-4-6-8 (omit treadle 2).
